

German Business Circles Call For Restraint Over EU Provocations

Germany's Foreign Policy newsletter reports German business associations calling on the EU Commission to end its Brexit provocations.

The President of the German Chambers of Industry and Commerce (DIHK) warned that an amicable Brexit agreement with London must be reached as a disorderly Brexit will entail enormous costs for the German economy. The Federation of German Industries (BDI) expressed a similar view.

The EU's Commission's audacious financial demands and deliberate indiscretions cause massive resentment in the United Kingdom and are rightfully considered attempts to influence Britain's parliamentary elections.

Such interferences by EU President Jean-Claude Juncker and the German Chief of Staff, Martin Selmayr (CDU), are entirely inappropriate as both play a key role in the Commission's Brexit negotiations.

Even the German Chancellery is calling for restraint in view of the severe damage a hard Brexit could entail for the German economy.
